### **Tuesday 10th June 2025**

A meeting took place at Lymm Cruising Club on Tuesday 10th June 2025. There were eight members in attendance and two apologies were given.

## <u>Chairman's Report</u>

### **Secretary's Report**

Two dingys had been abandoned on the canal. One was on tow path side of canal opposite Lymm Cruising Club's moorings the other one was abandoned in the woods near Lymm Cruising Club. Both were removed for safety reasons.

Concern was raised regarding a Facebook page that had been set up by a boater with a go fund me page to raise money for the boater's affected by the breach. Unfortunately no further information was available.

The Secretary had been asked if cycling on tow path was allowed near The Red Lion. It was clarified that cycling is allowed from Acton Grange Bridge onwards heading towards Runcorn.

She had also forwarded previous minutes to the police at Stockton Heath Station informing them of the up coming meeting.

#### **Incidents/Reports**

All members present reported that things were very quite and no major problems.

There were a few CRT boats that were stuck at Sale due to the breach BCC are aware and are monitoring the situation.

On the Runcorn Arm there are numerous overhanging branches and an up- rooted tree the situation will be checked by BCC. A fallen tree had been pulled to the off side of canal near Walton. Due to a club visit and Sound in the City event the Caslefield arms will be closed to moorers from June 23rd until 25th July 2025.
